- All children over the age of 12 must have something they can hold onto to stabilise themselves whilst on the float.
- There are to be no throwing of objects from the floats. People may walk beside the float and hand out items.

Please assemble floats at the stable end of showgrounds at 11am (enter through horse gate at the bottom end of showgrounds). The procession will be held in the Showground ring at 12pm Saturday 26 June 2021. Floats will enter the ring at bottom/stables ring gate and proceed around the circumference of the ring. At the end of the procession floats can be parked outside the ring in the designated area for attendees to further view and admire the floats. Size will be limited to floats that will fit through the ring gate and can manoeuvre easily around the ring.
